Doesn't it drive you crazy when someone comes up to you and says, "Oh I've heard such terrible news. It's so sad. But I can't tell you what it is, because I promised I would say nothing." I hate that, and I want to say, "Why bring it up at all, if you can't tell me what it is?"

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the disciples, "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now." You can imagine the disciples' frustration. But He meant to assure them that whatever comes, He will be there to help them.

Imagining of big challenges in life, our first reaction is: "I don't have the strength to face that. I will not be able to cope, if those things happen to me." It is then that we must trust in the Lord. Jesus tells us, "You do not even know what is going to happen, but I do. I am already taking steps so that when the challenges in your life come, you will have the resources to deal with them."

In her classic book, "The Hiding Place", Corrie Ten Boom tells of her experience when she was 8 years old. Their neighbor lost their three-month old child. Corrie went with her mother to pay respects. As her mother spoke to the grieving parents, Corrie approached the crib in which the dead child lay. She reached out and touched him. He was cold. For the first time in her life, Corrie had touched death! That chill entered her heart. That evening she could not sleep, and she began to cry. Her father heard her and asked her "what's the matter." She explained, "I touched the dead child today and I know that death is real. I know that one day death will come, and take you and momma from me. I can't face that. I will never be strong enough to let you go." The father thought for a while then calmly asked, "Corrie, when we take the train to Amsterdam, do I give you your ticket while we are at home?" she said, "No. You give it to me just before we climb on the train, because you are afraid that if you give it earlier I will lose it." The father said, "Exactly;" and continued, "You need to know that God is much wiser than I am. Today, you do not have the strength to face the challenges to come. But when the day comes on which you must face pain or even death, your ticket will be ready. Your Heavenly Father has already bought it and is holding it for you. It will be there when you need it."

We want to know that we have the strength to face whatever will come. But we do not even know what we will have to face then. God does and has already prepared a way for us to address the difficulties ahead. That is why we must entrust our future to God's care. We trust that when we must face loss, pain or death, then the ticket will be placed in our hand.



 and lay faithful of the Archdiocese:**


*This year marks an infamous anniversary,

LOBSTER DINNER @ ST. ANTHONY'S


Friday, June 21st, 6:00 PM
