#### **PROJECT ADVANCE UPDATE**

As the year end approaches, we are now in the final phase of Project Advance 2023. We thank everyone who donated to the appeal this year.

This year, our goal is to raise \$125,000. Currently we have raised \$53,145 with a participation rate of 20% of our parishioners. The amount raised includes \$33,600 which is designated for the Archdiocese. After Project Advance administrative expenses, which have been paid, our total parish rebate is currently \$14,255. Further funds raised will support our own parish projects.

Financially, this year has been difficult for everyone and for our parish. The organ in the church is aging and it must be replaced in the next few months. The expected cost is \$31,000. Also, new commercial pots and pans are required for our kitchen. These new projects will need funding from Project Advance. Project Advance is a community-based appeal, and its strength is founded on the number donations received. Therefore, every gift regardless of the amount will make a big impact and is greatly appreciated.

We encourage everyone to prayerfully consider whether a donation to Project Advance is possible this year.
