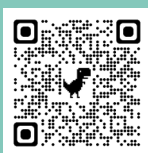

This is the official callout for new and returning vendors to participate in this fun and well-attended community event.

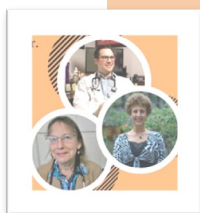
